

### Investment Strategy

The investment seeks to provide current income as well as long-term capital appreciation. The fund's adviser employs a "value approach" in making its common stock selections. Generally, the advisor will attempt to remain fully invested in common stocks and securities that are convertible into common stocks, such as convertible bonds and convertible preferred stocks. The fund may invest in the securities of issuers of all sizes and market capitalizations.

Disclosure: The Fund's total annual operating expense ratio as stated in the fee table of the Fund's most recent prospectus is 1.25%. The total operating expense as reported in the FAM Dividend Focus Fund's audited financial statements as of December 31, 2020 is 1.24%. The Advisor has contractually agreed, until May 1, 2022, to waive fees and/or reimburse the Fund certain expenses (excluding interest, taxes, brokerage costs, Acquired Fund Fees and Expenses, dividend expense and extraordinary expenses) to the extent necessary to maintain Net Fund Operating Expenses for Investor Shares at 1.26%.



Sortino Ratio is similar to Sharpe Ratio except it uses downside risk (Downside Deviation) in the denominator. Standard Deviation is a statistical measurement of dispersion about an average, which, for a mutual fund, depicts how widely the returns varied over a certain period of time. R- Squared reflects the percentage of a portfolio's movements that can be explained by movements in its benchmark. Beta is a measure of systematic risk with respect to a benchmark. Max Drawdown is the peak to trough decline during a specific record period of an investment or fund.							The Morningstar Rating <sup>31</sup> for funds, or "star rating", is calculated for funds with at least a three-year history. (Exchange-traded funds and open-end mutual funds are considered a single population for comparative purposes.) It is calculated based on a Morningstar Risk-Adjusted Return measure that accounts for variation in a fund's monthly excess performance (excluding the effect of sales charges, if any), placing more emphasis on downward variations and rewarding consistent performance. The top 10% of funds in each fund category receive 5 stars, the next 22.5% receive 4 stars, the next 35% receive 3 stars, the next 22.5% receive 2 stars, and the bottom 10% receive 1 star.
